

Milkweed of Washington

3 species recorded. USDA zones 4a-9a. Monarch flyway: western. Sow seed outdoors October to December, so the seed uses winter rain.

Native species

- ☐ **Showy Milkweed**
Asclepias speciosa - 2ft-5ft - pink, rose - May to August - Average/Dry soil
- ☐ **Narrowleaf Milkweed**
Asclepias fascicularis - 2ft-4ft - white, pink, green - May to September - Dry/Average soil
- ☐ **Pallid Milkweed**
Asclepias cryptoceras - 4in-1ft - cream, pink - April to June - Dry soil
